

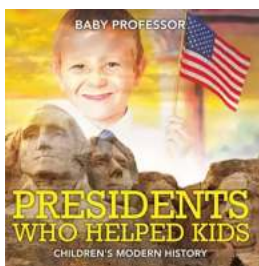
5 Presidents Who Changed the Lives of Children in Modern History

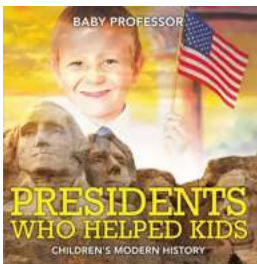
