
The Legacy of Pearl Harbor Survivors

On December 7, 1941, Japan waged a surprise attack on the United States Naval Base at Pearl Harbor. 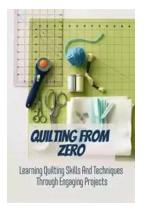
