

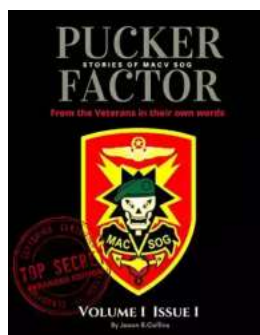

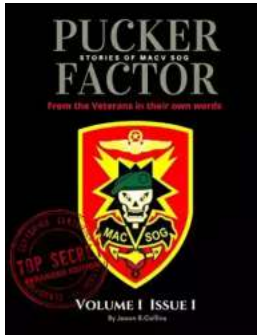

I returned to civilian life July 1970 after three Vietnam combat tours. The last two of those tours were with MACV SOG. Looking back 50+ years during my time in

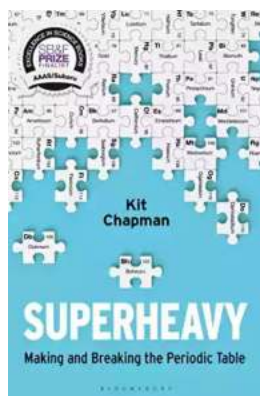
